Thanks to a generous grant from the Athens County Foundation, we developed and delivered "STEAM Packs for Classrooms" to every first grade class in Athens County. These hands-on lessons support students and teachers as they study mapmaking, ancient (and recent) history of our region, and natural resources found right here in Ohio. We even debuted two weeks of summer camp fun this year at the Shade Community Center!


Collaborations in 2022 ranged from Community Food Initiatives to Ohio University, from the WOUB Learning Lab to the Southeast Ohio History Center, and other partnerships that work to strengthen and extend each organization's individual impact in southeast Ohio. Opportunities for teens planned by our Teen Science Café leaders brought together middle and high school students with researchers and experts in climate science, physics, and paleontology. Our Discovery Lab program returned to in-person events where we explored technology, eSports, magnets, and more. Building these type of skills and a knowledge base for 21st century learners is a great way to build a foundation for future careers. 
#### FOR ATHENS COUNTY **CLASSROOMS**


### OVMoD on the Road
